WAKE UP!

I was driving my son to work one early morning. On the return trip to my home I felt very sleepy. It was a concentrated effort to keep my eyes open and focus on the road. The sleepy feeling was prominent and if I could close my eyes I would enjoy sweet sleep. However, I was roused to reality as I did not want to have a car accident and injure others/ myself or even kill someone or myself. The urgency to wake up was greater than the enticement to sleep. The spirit of the Lord began to minister to me and shared that many are falling asleep or are asleep in the spiritual realm. We are not as alert as we should be about our walk with God. Romans 13:11 (Amplified Bible) says, "Besides this you know what (a critical) hour this is, how it is high time now for you to wake up out of your sleep (rouse to reality). For salvation (final deliverance) is nearer to us now than when we first believed (adhered to, trusted in, and relied on Christ the Messiah)."
