What's love got to do with it? "For the love of Christ controls and urges and impels us, because we are of the opinion and conviction that [if] One died for all, then all died; and He died for all, so that all those who live might live no longer to and for themselves but to and for Him Who died and was raised again for their sake." 2 Corinthians 5: 14-15 (AMP)

Amen (so be it)." Stay in love with the Lord and be sure He is your first love as you don't want to miss out spending eternity with the Lover of your Soul, Jesus!
