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YOU HAVE THE MIND OF CHRIST

"Let this mind be in you which also was in Christ Jesus;" Philippians 2:5



Christians often accept being defeated in their walk with God by accepting the concept that one cannot live in victory. When one feels weak, they may often say, "I'm not Jesus, He's the only perfect one." Although this statement appears to accurately depict the weakness of man and the righteousness of Jesus Christ, there is a down side to this type of thinking. Remember, one limits the level of success achieved based on one's mindset. If you believe you are going to fail, then the likelihood of failing is greater.
